SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CERRITOS AND REPRESENTED FULL-TIME AND TEMPORARY, PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF AFSCME LOCAL 619, COUNCIL 36

January 3, 2025

The attached updated classification tables have been reviewed and agreed upon by both parties with the following caveats:

- Public Works and Administrative Services Departments will work together to provide on the job training for employees transitioning from the Custodian I to Custodial and Building Maintenance classification. Approximately 10% of the incumbents time will be spent on these revised duties, depending on operational needs.
- 2. Three Recreation Services Coordinator positions will be converted to Recreation Services Supervisor positions through an internal competitive process. Until the additional supervisors are selected, the existing coordinators will receive a \$500/month stipend. Both parties agree to checkin on the process at the 90 and 180 marks.
- 3. The workload and hours for the Theater Operations Coordinator position will be monitored.
- 4. Changes will be revisited over the next six months to address: unforeseen impacts of the organizational changes that were not identified prior to the meet and confer process; major revisions to classification specifications that were not identified prior to the meet and confer process; adjustments to the classification tables, if external equity requirements necessitate refinements.
